ECAT Overview



Escambia Area Transit (ECAT) provides citizens with safe, convenient and affordable public transportation throughout the Escambia County/Pensacola area since 1950.



ECAT currently has 1,050+ bus stops covering 285 miles of routes which average 1.3 million annual passenger trips.

- 22 bus routes
- Seasonal Pensacola Beach trolley (provided by Santa Rosa Island Authority)
- University of West Florida (UWF) on-campus trolley
- ADA paratransit services (operated by ECCT)





Community Transportation



In 2014, Escambia County became the local Community Transportation Coordinator (CTC) which coordinates medical and non-medical transportation services.

In 2017, Escambia County Community Transportation was incorporated into the ECAT/Mass Transit Department.

- ECAT's ADA Complimentary Paratransit Services
- Non-Sponsored Services for the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged
- Agency Sponsored Trips such as Council on Aging and Vocational Rehabilitation




