Santa Rosa County Sheriff's Office continues to participate in the Gulf Coast High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Program in obtaining a grant each year. Agencies participating as sub-recipients and providing task force officers include the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (Pensacola Office), Pensacola Police Department, Gulf Breeze Police Department, Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office, and the Florida Highway Patrol. As lead agency in assuming the administrative and financial responsibilities as outlined in the grant conditions, it is my responsibility to prepare the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with each agency.

Enclosed please find the FY 21 HIDTA sub-recipient MOA for the Pensacola Police Department and required certifications (Certification Regarding Debarment, Suspension, Ineligibility and Voluntary Exclusion; Certification Requiring Drug Free Workplace; Certification Regarding Lobbying; and EEOP Certification).
