










TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATIONS (TPO/MPO)







The role of the

METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (MPO)

We refer to the MPOs as the Transportation Planning Organizations (TPO).



Federal and **State Law** require a Metropolitan **Planning Organization** (MPO) to be designated...


...in each urbanized area with a population of 50,000 or more.




What is a Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO)?



Project Priorities

Project Priorities are a list of the Cost Feasible projects from the Long Range Transportation Plan in Priority order. They are provided to FDOT annually for funding in the Work Program.

(LRTP) LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN

- Must be adopted every five years
- Minimum planning horizon of 20 yrs
- Developed with public input

PROJECT PRIORITIES

- Adopted Annually
- Provided annually to FDOT for potential funding in the Work Program

FDOT FIVE YEAR WORK PROGRAM

- Must be adopted every year
- Funds become available in annual appropriations from the Legislature to fund various project phases
