Please be advised that Proposed Ordinance No. 09-23 was presented to the City Council of the City of Pensacola for first reading on Thursday, April 27, 2023, and will be presented for final reading and adoption on Thursday, May 11, 2023 at 5:30 p.m., in Council Chambers on the First Floor of City Hall, 222 West Main Street, Persacola, Florida. The title of the proposed ordinance is as follows:

P.O. #09-23: (T.O. 1072) AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 7.4-1, 7.4-2, 7.4-3, 7.4-4, 7.4-6, AND 7.4-11 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PENSACOLA, FLORIDA; REMOVING AUTHORI-TY TO OPERATE BOTTLE CLUBS; ADDING DEFINITION OF RESTAURANT; LIMIT-ING RESTRUCTION ON NUMBER AND LOCATION OF ESTABLISHMENTS WHERE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CAN BE SOLD: EXPANDING THE EXEMPTION FOR RES TAURANT TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
