

COMMUNITY POLICING & THE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY

Increase presence/visibility in the Community Redevelopment Area

- Create visual deterrent for nuisances
- Increases police response time to incidents in the area
- Direct route for business owners and residents to engage with officers and address concerns, problems, and violations
- Promotes a positive relationship with the businesses and residents as well as strengthening the bond between the police and the community

OBJECTIVE #1







> Address on-going problems in the CRA area

- Disorderly behavior at Downtown night clubs and businesses
- > Provide security for patrons that visits the Community Redevelopment Area
- Address other City ordinance violations
- Pro-actively enforce public safety concerns during special events such baseball games, festivals, and gallery night

OBJECTIVE #2

- Outfit the officers with the appropriate uniforms and equipment
- The police will use bicycle and foot patrol
- Targeted enforcement during chronic nuisance times
- During targeted shifts more officers will be utilized to promote omnipresence
- > The Sergeant will manage the schedule
- An activity letter will be completed after each shift and the Sergeant will review the letter
- The Criminal Investigation Captain will manage/store the letters for auditing and forward the letters to the CRA Administrator

THE PLAN



- Lower crime
- Strengthen relationship with police and community
- Improve the City of Pensacola's image as a safe and accommodating area for commerce and leisure within the CRA area.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

SINCE JUNE 19TH 2017

- 24 drug related arrests
- 1 gun related arrest
- 8 misc. arrests (theft, driving violations, fights...)
- 1 burglary arrest
- 1 city ordinance arrest
- 6 Baker Acts or Marchman Acts
- 20 warnings issued for minor violations (open containers, panhandling)

SINCE JUNE 19TH 2017

- Hundreds of citizen contacts
- Community bike rides
- Supplement CRA area events (4th of July fireworks, Gallery Night, Wahoo's games...
- Frequent monitoring of monuments and parks
- Assisting citizens in need/ crisis (Baker Acts, changing tires, providing night time escorts from businesses,
- Positive interaction with children and CRA area parks and daycares
