- 1. Installation of <u>additional overhead street lights</u>, <u>and street level</u> and pedestrian <u>level lighting throughout the length of the corridor from A Street to Dominguez Street</u>
- Installation of low curb, safe haven/mid-block crossings where
 pedestrian involved crashes have occurred as identified in the
 CMP, or where pedestrian counts / generators warrant such,
 where they will not conflict with the long term roadway
 rebalancing proposal
- 3. Upgraded traffic signalization (ATMS technologies), inclusion of flashing beacons at existing pedestrian crossings such as flashing lights

- 4. Crosswalk enhancements at the most hazardous, high intensity crosswalks.
- 5. Installation of new pavement markings (high visibility thermoplastic striping, RPM's, etc.), and installation of new and/or additional traffic control and pedestrian signage for entire corridor
- 6. Refurbish pedestrian sidewalks where necessary
- 4.7. ADA upgrades to curb ramps, bus stops, etc. for corridor
