As a follow-up to our conversation please pass this email along to the persons that you feel are a responsible party for whom can assist in securing the Tall Ship Lynx berthing for a portion of the upcoming winter.

Tall Ship Lynx, a US Coast Guard Inspected vessel of sub chapter "T" registry #1114674 with a mission of education and aligned curriculum to Florida's Department of Education "State Standards" using "Researched based best practices in teaching" seeks a working partner IE. Visit Pensacola, not in a financial way but in the spirit of marketing and mention of the ships presents as an additional educational and cultural amenity, available and open to the public for tours and sailings in Pensacola. Lynx is owned and operated by the Lynx Educational Foundation, is a traditionally rigged ship evoking the era of The War of 1812, Lynx herself is a national treasure. America's Privateer Lynx requests to be alongside in the vicinity of berth 14 at Plaza de Luna.

In exchange for waved dockage fees Lynx would provide free access to school groups coordinated with our education director, also Lynx would provide free ships tours daily, open to the public on a regular posted schedule 6 days a week including weekdays and weekends. To offset the expense of educational opportunities and public offerings that we solely underwrite, the Lynx Educational Foundation will offer ticketed public sailings, charters and special event sailings.

It is our desire to honor the warm welcome we received from our visit during last year's Tall Ship Festival and the many people that expressed for Lynx to "please come pack".

Lvnx is staffed full time with licensed crew members, the Lvnx Educational roundation is a member of a USCG CFK qualified random drug testing consortium, and all crew are subject to consortium.

I look forward to exploring a Lynx visit to your beautiful city this winter with dates yet to be confirmed but, in the vicinity of repruary 5 to March 10, 2019.
