#### **Monitoring COVID-19**

In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, the U.S. Census Bureau has adjusted 2020 Census operations to protect the health and safety of our employees and the public, and to ensure a complete and accurate count of all communities based on guidance from federal, state, and local health authorities.

#### 2020 Census Operational Adjustments Due to COVID-19

- ✓ We're adapting or delaying some of our operations to protect the health and safety of our staff and the public and make sure we get the same population counted another way.
- ✓ Thousands of personnel are adhering to social distancing policy and continuing to work from home.
- ✓ We're conducting a series of preparatory activities so we are fully ready to resume field activities as we continue to advance the mission of the 2020 Census to ensure a complete and accurate count.
- ✓ In-person activities, including enumeration, office work, and processing activities, will always incorporate the most current guidance from authorities to ensure the health and safety of staff and the public.

**Information provided daily to the Census Bureau from FEMA**, as well as State and Local authorities, will be used to guide Census Bureau decisions on timing. As a result, selected field operations will resume on a phased schedule on a geographic basis.

#### STATUS OF CURRENT OPERATIONS

#### **Self-Response Phase**

Online, phone and mailed self-responses continue throughout the data collection process.

**Scheduled** March 12 – July 3 **EXTENDED October 31** 

#### **Group Quarters (E-Response & Paper Enumeration)**

Many group quarters have already begun responding through our e-Response enumeration option.

Scheduled April 2 – June 5 EXTENDED September 3

#### **Update Leave - Stateside**

Census takers drop off invitations to respond and paper questionnaires at the front doors of 5 million households stateside while updating the addresses.

Planned Schedule March 15 – April 17 EXTENDED Select ACOs starting May 4

#### Nonresponse Followup (NRFU)

Census takers will interview households in person. New dates will cover areas previously scheduled for "Early NRFU."

Scheduled May 13 – July 31 Revised Schedule August 11 – October 31












## **ESCAMBIA COUNTY RESPONSE RATE**







### FLORIDA CENSUS RESPONSE RATE

#### FACTORS AFFECTING OVERALL RESPONSE RATE

- COVID-19 obstacles
- CENSUS DAY April 1 mistaken as deadline
- Unincorporated areas rely on overlap of nearby
- Young People / College residents not engaged
- SEASONAL HOMES / VACANT ADDRESSES
- RURAL AREAS
  - Areas has less message overlap
  - Limited or no internet access
  - Message hasn't reached or received well



### **FLORIDA CENSUS RESPONSE RATE**

#### WHAT CAN WE DO?

Leadership appeal - add your name and face to digital message

Grow the team of voices for more help for local news, social media digital push

- Re-enlist local chamber, small businesses, non-profits and social organizations
- Solicit use of digital media boards schools, banks, churches, sporting locations
- Transportation systems for mobile billboards
- Drop short census message on utility bills, email push, well being calls
- Distribute/display census materials and posters at food pantries or give-aways
- Re-engage undercounted groups foreign-born, non-English, LGBTQ, military/Vet
- Participate in initiatives like: Children initiatives to engage more families













