

The Establishment of Pensacola's Redevelopment Agency & Districts

1980's -

- City Council created the Community Redevelopment Agency
- Established the Urban Core Redevelopment District

2000's -

- Established the Eastside Redevelopment District
- Established the Westside Redevelopment District

For Each Redevelopment District, City Council:

- Found Necessity under F.S.
- Adopted a Redevelopment Plan
- Created a Redevelopment Trust Fund

The Purpose of the CRA

- Elimination and prevention of slum or blight
- Rehabilitation or conservation of the redevelopment districts
- Preservation or enhancement of the tax base
- Affordable housing, for rent or for sale
- Reduction or prevention of crime, including community policing innovations
- Preparation and administration of adopted redevelopment plans



MLK / DAVIS TWO-WAY CONVERSION



- Return of MLK/Alcaniz
 & Davis to Two-Way
 Streets from I-110 to
 Wright Street
- Supports traffic calming and neighborhood livability
- Traverses Eastside CRA, Urban Core CRA, and Escambia County
- Managed by FDOT

HOLLICE T. WILLIAMS URBAN GREENWAY AND SKATE PARK



- VISION: Art Infused Urban Greenway
- Design funded by RESTORE grant
- Active community garden located within the southernmost portion of park
- Multi-purpose skate park to be co-located within proximity of garden
- Spans between Urban Core and Eastside districts


