A RESOLUTION
TO BE ENTITLED:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PENSACOLA, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF THE DESIGNATION OF STATE ROADWAY TO HONOR FALLEN PENSACOLA POLICE OFFICERS AS, "PENSACOLA POLICE FALLEN HEROES HIGHWAY"; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) allows for roadways in the State of Florida to be designated for memorial or honorary purposes. Currently, the General Daniel "Chappie" James Memorial Bridge, the Bayou Texar Bridge, and a portion of East Cervantes Street are just some of the Memorial Highways within the city limits; and

WHEREAS, Bayfront Parkway, from Tarragona Street to the new General Daniel "Chappie" James Memorial Bridge, is entirely in the city limits, passes directly by Veterans' Memorial Park, and serves as a gateway to Pensacola, the beaches and points east of that location.

WHEREAS, designating this roadway would honor the sixteen men who lost their lives in service of the City of Pensacola and be a reminder to families, friends, current and former officers, and citizens that the sacrifice has not been forgotten.

WHEREAS, upon passage, the FDOT would fund and erect the signs. There is no cost to the PPD or City of Pensacola.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PENSACOLA, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That City Council supports designation of state roadway to honor fallen PPD officers.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall become effective on the fifth business day after adoption, unless otherwise provided, pursuant to Section 4.03(d) of the City Council of the City of Pensacola.
