JULY 17, 1821

Spanish governor transferred Florida to Governor Andrew Jackson, USA

Formal ceremony took place in Pensacola

• Only 2 counties in new Territory: Escambia and St. Johns

New form of government established: democracy

ORGANIZATION AND EVENTS

2021 Commemoration Commission for County and City

- Chair, Dr. Judy Bense, Co-Chair Ms. Margo Stringfield, began January 2019
- 13 diverse commission members
- Funded by County, City and state matching request
- Events by local organizations leading up to July 2021
 - Monthly Archaeological Society presentations (virtual)
 - St. Michaels cemetery tour of 1821 residents graves
 - Weekly historical articles in PNJ

July 17, 2021 Commemoration Event Committee

- Representatives from 19 organizations will participate
- Plan "A": Formal ceremony in Museum Plaza
 - Public invited
 - VIPs: Spanish consulate, Florida Governor, Secretary of State, Mayor, County Commission chair, local dignitaries
 - Native and African American and Hispanic performances
 - Music: Navy band, mariachi band
 - Flag ceremony
 - Reenactors
 - Booths along plaza and in historic district
 - Food, special historic drink, breakfast
