Please be advised that Proposed Ordinance No. 12-21 was presented to the Gity Council of the Gity of Pensacola for first reading on Thursday, April 22, 2021 and will be presented for final reading and adoption on Thursday, May 13, 2021 at 530 pm, in Council Chambers on the First Floor of Gity Hall, 222 West Main Street, Pensacola, Florida.

P.O. 11:2-11: AN ORDINANCE GREATING SECTION 4-2-45 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PEN-SACULA, FLORIDA; PROVIDING REGULATIONS FOR THE BREEDING OF DOMESTI-CATED ANIMALS; REQUIREMENTS FOR LCENSURE AND PERMITTING FOR HOBBY BREEDEK; PROVIDING FOR DEFINITIONS; AMENDING SECTION 7-2-9 TO PROVID-ING FEE FOR LOCAL BUSINESS TAX FOR HOBBY BREEDERS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
