Project specifics/description:

The UWF Historic Trust is seeking conceptual review for a covering over a locomotive, flatcar,
and restored caboose along the side of the Museum of Industry. This covering will help protect
three of the largest collection items on display. Being mindful of the historic building
and sensitive archaeological site, this design minimizes ground disturbance and physical
connections the brick building. A row of metal columns between the train and the building will
supporting a translucent panel system used as roofing. This design takes inspiration from the
industrial nature of railroads, historic train sheds, and the adjacent historic commercial buildings
