Council President Cannada-Wynn indicated submission of online requests to speak has closed and suggested allowing the public to address Council regarding the proposed budget at the beginning of the workshop.

### DISCUSSION

1. <u>20-00521</u> CITY COUNCIL WORKSHOP - FISCAL YEAR 2021 PROPOSED BUDGET

While trying to reach public input speakers Council President Cannada-Wynn moved forward with the departmental schedule as provided in the memorandum dated 9/2/20.

#### Financial Services - Budget Brief and Overview:

Finance Director Lovoy provided an overhead presentation (on file with background materials and attached).

Public input was heard from the following individuals (via phone held to a mic):

**Nathan Marona:** Addressed Council suggesting a portion of proposed funding for the Pensacola Police Department be reallocated for other services such as affordable housing, health services and community centers.

**Jamil Davis:** Also suggested reallocation of a portion funding proposed for law enforcement for other services.

**Anthony Caldwell:** Addressed Council regarding needed improvements for Magee Field and (its) facilities.

Public input continued:

**Christian Wagley:** Addressed Council representing Healthy Gulf regarding long-term environmental action goals, such as referenced in the Climate Mitigation and Adaption Task Force final report and recommendation and urged that the budget should reflect moving toward those goals.

**Liz Watkins:** Addressed Council suggesting an identifiable line item for human services rather than throughout the budget. She also made comments regarding the local housing crisis.

# **Local Options Sales Tax (LOST) Discussion:**

Finance Director Lovoy referenced a spreadsheet (on overhead projection, hardcopies provided and provided electronically via email - - on file with background materials and attached) *LOST Series IV Plan as of 7/31/20*. She invited Council Members to discuss any re-prioritization of projects.

Council President Cannada-Wynn indicated she would like to move forward department by department as provided in the schedule (attached and on file with background materials) and discuss LOST projects as related to each department.

Mayor Robinson, Finance Director Lovoy, City Administrator Wilkins, City Attorney Woolf and appropriate departmental staff responded accordingly to questions and comments throughout the department by department discussion. Council Executive Kraher also provided input.

Discussion also took place regarding the process to bring forth changes to allocations. Council Executive Kraher indicated he and Council Strategic Budget Planner Kruszona will work individually with Council Members wishing to propose amendments to budget allocation which will be brought forward at the first public hearing on the FY 2021 Proposed Budget on September 9<sup>th</sup>.
