1. <u>20-00593</u> EXTENSION OF MAYORAL DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR HURRICANE SALLY

Recommendation: That City Council approve the Mayor's request for an extension of the Declaration of Emergency for Hurricane Sally until the Council meeting scheduled for October 22, 2020.

A motion to approve was made by Council Member Hill and seconded by Council Member Jerralds.

City Attorney Woolf referenced the information provided in the agenda materials, specifically outlined in the memorandum dated 9/21/20 and clarified the authority of the mayor under Section 2-4-8 of the City Code, indicating this extension would be for a period of thirty-one (31) days.

Mayor Robinson addressed Council providing an update of the City's emergency response to Hurricane Sally.

Public Works & Facilities Director Owens responded accordingly to questions related to damage assessments of city-owned property. Finance Director Lovoy responded to questions related to FEMA reimbursement. City Administrator Wilkins also provided input related to reported damage at the Port. Mayor Robinson and City Administrator Wilkins also responded to questions related to debris pick-up and removal for citizens.
