JACKSON STREET TRANSPORTATION MASTER PLAN

SUMMARY:

In July of 2021, Escambia County and the City of Pensacola Community Redevelopment Agency entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to develop a transportation master plan called "Reimagine Jackson Street: A Transportation Master Plan" for improvements to West Jackson Street from A Street to Fairfield Drive.
