That City Council adopt Proposed Ordinance No. 07-19 on second reading.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY PURSUANT TO AND CONSISTENT WITH THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE CITY OF PENSACOLA; AMENDING THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF PENSACOLA; REPEALING CLAUSE AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

SUMMARY:

Centennial Imports, LLC is requesting to rezone the property located at 3100 Navy Boulevard from

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Commercial (C-1 and C-2) to Commercial (C-3). The current future land use category of Commercial would accommodate this rezoning and so this request does not include a change to the future land use designation. The property is currently occupied by Centennial Imports, LLC, used car dealership. The applicant indicates the reason for this request is to make the zoning consistent. This request has been routed through the various City departments and utility providers and those comments are attached for your review.

On February 12, 2019, the Planning Board recommended approval of the proposed Zoning Map amendment by a vote of 5 to 1.
