Due to supply chain impacts, Pensacola Energy requests authorization for the early purchase of natural gas meters and remote transmitters. These items are scheduled for purchase each year and, since there is a significant timeline delay in the industry, it is necessary to appropriate them now for delivery in Fiscal Year 2023.
