**SUMMARY:**

The landscape architecture firm SCAPE identified two (2) catalytic projects for the downtown waterfront; Bruce Beach enhancement whereby it is reimagined as a cultural, recreational and educational hub and the Hashtag Connector, converting Cedar Street into a low-speed, curbsless "shared street," open to both pedestrian and vehicular traffic.
