## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That City Council hold a Public Hearing on January 17, 2019 regarding the amendment to the Land Development Code Section 12-12-4--Vacation Streets, Alleys.

**HEARING REQUIRED:** Public

## **SUMMARY:**

At their September 13, 2018 City Council Meeting, City Council sent to the Planning Board for review and recommendation a proposed amendment to Section 12-12-4 - Vacation Streets, Alleys, of the Land Development Code.

Within this proposed amendment is included language which states:

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... When a request for vacation of a right of way adjacent to a street or alley is made, the vacation shall be limited to a minimum of no less than 10' from the existing back-of-curb. In no ease shall a right of way vacation result in a lesser level of accessibility to the public, Any existing sidewalk on a right of way must be maintained or rebuilt by an owner granted such a vacation in order to preserve ADA accessibility to the public.

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Also included is cleanup language bringing the Code up to date with current City staffing and departments.

This item requires a Public Hearing be held.
