**SUBJECT:**

REMOVAL OF 10 TREES AT THE FEDERAL COURTHOUSE RENOVATION SITE

**SUMMARY:**

On or about 29<sup>th</sup> or 30<sup>th</sup>, trees were removed from the corner of Palafox and Garden Street near the site of the Federal Courthouse renovation. The contractor, Yates Construction, has agreed to replace the trees when the exterior work on the site is complete, in the latter part of 2019.
