RECOMMENDATION:

That City Council adopt Proposed Ordinance No. 21-20 on second reading:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 50-07 AS SUBSEQUENTLY AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 17-08; PROVIDING A DATE CERTAIN FOR DETERMINATION OF A COASTAL HIGH-HAZARD AREA BOUNDARY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

SUMMARY:

In 2007 under Ordinance No. 50-07 the Zoning Classification pursuant to the Comprehensive Plan

File #: 21-20, Version: 2

was amended. In 2008 under Ordinance No. 17-08, Ordinance No. 50-07 was amended redesignating the Zoning Classification of a portion of the Sonia Drive property as Conservation (CO). Within this amendment a boundary was set for the portion of the property located within the Coastal High Hazard Area which included the language, "as re-designated from time to time."

This action item sets the boundary as that approved on February 13, 2008 thereby removing the "redesignated from time to time language."

There is no adjustment to the Zoning Map, only setting a static boundary.

February 13, 2008 - City Council amended Ordinance No. 50-07 by passed Ordinance 17-08

April 23, 2020 - City Council voted to approve Proposed Ordinance No. 21-20 on first reading.
