#### SUBJECT:

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 39-20: REQUEST TO VACATE RIGHT OF WAY - 310 BAY BOULEVARD AND 306 BAY BOULEVARD

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That City Council adopt Proposed Ordinance No. 39-20 on second reading.

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING, ABANDONING AND VACATING A PORTION OF BAY BOULEVARD IN PENSACOLA, ESCAMBIA COUNTY, STATE OF FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

#### HEARING REQUIRED: Public

#### SUMMARY:

The City has received a request from Mary Catherine and Louis E. Harper III for a Vacation of Rightof-Way (ROW) of Bay Boulevard (a 20' right-of-way) on 310 Bay Boulevard (Lots 6, 7 and 8, Block 3, East Pensacola) and 306 Bay Boulevard (East half of Lot 3 and all of Lots 4 and 5). The applicant has stated the ROW is no longer needed as a public thoroughfare in that it does not provide access to any other public road or ROW and that it terminates on Lot 7, Block 3.

On July 14, 2020 the Planning Board voted 4 to 1 to recommend approval of the request.

August 13, 2020 - The City Council conducted a public hearing and approved Proposed Ordinance No. 39-20 on first reading.
