### **SUMMARY:**

The Pensacola Fire Department has been awarded a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) FY 2019 Grant to replace the aged self-contained breathing apparatus of the entire Fire Department. The total project cost to replace the self-contained breathing apparatus is \$619,115.84. The replacements are required as the currently owned self-contained breathing apparatus are not

upgradeable.

**PRIOR ACTION:**

September 16, 2020 - City Council adopted Budget Resolution No. 2020-43, which included an appropriation of \$95,200 in the Local Option Sales Tax Series IV plan for the City's grant match portion.
