#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That City Council adopt Resolution No. 2021-34.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PENSACOLA, FLORIDA, FOR THE SUBORDINATION OF CITY UTILITY INTEREST BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) AND CITY OF PENSACOLA (CITY) d/b/a PENSACOLA ENERGY FOR PARCEL 100.3R, SEGMENT #2224761, MANAGING DISTRICT 3, COUNTY ESCAMBIA.

#### **HEARING REQUIRED:** No Hearing Required

#### SUMMARY:

Pensacola Energy acquired the easement along the 12 inch and 16 inch gas lines from Gulf South during the pipeline acquisition in 2012. FDOT has purchased the parcel south of S.R. No. 8 (I-10) containing the Thomas Eugene Moore Easement as recorded in DB 337 PG 771 for the purposes of

constructing a drainage pond and therefore requesting subordination of the 30 foot wide easement area that extends approximately 170' across the property corner. The City will maintain the right to operate and service its facilities within this area with new construction subject to FDOT permit approval. If relocation is necessary for FDOT highway purposes, the City shall have the right to receive reimbursement from FDOT for the relocation.
