SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET RESOLUTION NO. 17-24 - STATE OF FLORIDA, DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE JUSTICE GRANT - OUTDOOR RECREATION INSTRUCTION AND ADVENTURE CAMP

That City Council adopt Supplemental Budget Resolution No. 17-24.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND MAKING REVISIONS AND APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2017, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

SUMMARY:

The Parks and Recreation Department will offer an Outdoor Recreation Instruction and Adventure Camp as a diversion and intervention program targeted towards the needs of youth who are identified as at-risk of being involved in the juvenile justice program. The Florida Department of Juvenile Justice will reimburse the City at \$360.02 per youth for Outdoor Recreation Instruction, and \$288.02 per youth for Adventure Camp, not to exceed \$28,801.80.
