BACKGROUND:

Brian Spencer, SMP Architecture, is requesting conceptual review for a new two-family residential structure. This project received conceptual approval in September 2017 as well as a variance which increased the allowed height from 35 feet to 42.5 feet. The current plans show design modifications and minor site changes to the approved 2017 plans. However, the building itself remains a three-level duplex with garages and a guest suite (not an accessory dwelling unit) on the ground floor.
